DESCRIPTION

1K LOW VOC ETCH PRIMER is a one component, quick drying primer with excellent anticorrosion and adhesion properties. Suitable for sanded and cleaned bare steel, galvanized steel and aluminium sheet metal.

MIXING

Add between 10% to 20% 2K thinner.

SPRAY PRESSURE

30 PSI

GUN SET-UP

1.4-1.6 Compliant spray gun.

APPLICATION

Apply 1 - 2 light coats and allow 5-10 mins flash-off between coats.
Should be over coated with a 2K primer before application of the final topcoat.

POT LIFE

24 hours.

DRYING

Touch dry in 20-30 minutes at 20°C. Should be over coated within one hour.

STORAGE

Correctly stored material, in firmly closed original containers, has a shelf-life of over 1 year. Contents of opened containers should be used up quickly. Always replace cap immediately after use.
